FINAL JUDGMENT

Comes the Assistant District Attorneys, Mark Ward and Scott Lusk, who prosecutes for the State of Mississippi and comes the defendant, O.D. Smith, in his own proper person, with his attorneys of record, Hon. Donald Rafferty and Hon. Daphne Pattison. The defendant was brought before the Court and having been arraigned in open Court and having the indictment preferred against him herein of **Capital Murder**, says that he is not guilty. Thereupon comes a jury composed of Allison Davis, and eleven (11) others together with Three (3) alternates, all good and lawful men and women of Adams County, Mississippi, who were empaneled, chosen, accepted and sworn according to law, and after hearing all of the evidence, argument of counsel and receiving the instructions of the Court, retired (with the exception of the alternates who were then and there excused by the Court) to consider their verdict, being in charge of their Bailiff and presently returned into open Court and in the presence and hearing of the defendant and his counsel, the following verdict, to-wit:

**We, the Jury find the defendant, O.D. Smith not guilty of Capital Murder.**

Ordered by the Court that in accordance with the verdict of the jury, that the defendant, O.D. Smith, be fully and finally discharged from this charge.
